Celebrating 50 Years of Age Concern Stourbridge and Halesowen

May 2025 – Marks a significant milestone for Age Concern Stourbridge and Halesowen as the charity celebrates 50 years of dedicated service to the elderly and vulnerable members of the community. Established in response to a growing need for support, companionship, and care among older individuals, Age Concern has been a pillar of compassion and assistance since its inception.

Fifty years ago, leaders from Social Services, local churches, and members of the *Stourbridge Baden-Powell Guild* convened with a shared vision: to address the urgent needs of older residents facing isolation and vulnerability. This inaugural meeting sparked the formation of Age Concern (Now known as "Age *Concern Stourbridge and Halesowen"*), which quickly became a vital lifeline for many in the community.

It was more than just a project — it was a promise to look after those who had given so much but were at risk of being forgotten. Motivated by a shared commitment to community service and the values of Scouting and Guiding, Stourbridge Guild members came together to address the needs of older people in their community. Their tireless efforts laid the groundwork for what would become a lasting and impactful organization, driven by compassion, service, and a deep sense of social responsibility.

Derek Elton, who served as National President of the Baden-Powell Guild for many years, also held the role of President at Age Concern. His leadership, alongside dedicated Baden-Powell Guild members and other volunteers, significantly influenced the organization's ethos.

Over the decades, Age Concern Stourbridge and Halesowen has grown from a grassroots initiative to a cornerstone of support, providing essential services that include social activities, advocacy, and practical assistance. Through tireless dedication and unwavering commitment, the organization has positively impacted countless lives, fostering a sense of belonging and dignity among elderly residents.



Today, Age Concern continues to innovate and expand its services to meet the evolving needs of older adults in Stourbridge and Halesowen. The organization remains committed to its founding principles of compassion, inclusivity, and dignity for all. Though they may no longer walk beside us, we honour the memory of Baden – Powell Guild members with gratitude and pride.
