

Our Camp Sites



Site 1 – **(Holly Site)** a small site in a wood area suitable for a patrol size camp.

Site 2 – **(Muntjac Wood)** large site in a wood area suitable for a troop size camp. Due to the trees there is very little grass cover on the ground. Access from the car park is up a short slope through thick woodland but it does have a nice “on your own” feel about it. Not so good for younger ages as it is the furthest from the toilet block and water points.

Site 3 – **(Tower Site)** small site central to the camp suitable for a couple of patrols to camp. Please note due to the proximity of this site to the car park then it can be a bit noisy and it suffers from the car park lighting which is left on during the night (for some groups this is a plus).

Sites 4 – **(Comber Copse)** large wooded area normally hired as one site but can be split and booked for two small troop size camps. Often booked by D of E groups as it feels out of the way but has easy access to the Kinver Edge via the Comber Road pedestrian gate (coded lock). As this site is under the trees there is little grass cover.

Site 5 – **(Comber Gate)** a small site in a wood area suitable for a couple of patrols to camp. The site can feel out of the way to the rest of the camp but is still close to all the services. Popular with D of E groups and Explorer Scout Units as it is right by the Comber Road pedestrian gate (coded lock) which leads directly to Kinver Edge.

Site 6 – **(Lodge Site)** This is a collection of grassed areas by the Chief’s lodge and near the camp fire circle. Normally this site is reserved for hirers of the Lodge.

Site 7 – **(Birmingham Bank)** Expect to be carrying your camping kit up a fair steep incline to this large open grass site. It is suitable for large groups or can be used as two separate sites for smaller groups. It is in the main on sloping ground but close to toilet block.

Site 8 – **(Hill Top)** This is the top end of Site 7 but a nice flat site suitable for a small troop camp. For big groups this is often booked with Site 7.

Site 9 – **(Sunny Side)** Patrol or small Troop size grass area which gives a feeling of isolation from other sites. Like sites 7 and 8 there is a fairly steep bank up to the site. A nice quiet site good for smaller groups who want to be out of the way of the main site.

Sites 10 - **(Foxes Run)** good size grass areas central to the site and by the activity field. For large group camps these are often booked together with site 11.

Site 11 – **(Chief’s Site)** good size grass areas central to the site and by the activity field. For large group camps these are often booked together with site 10. Ground slopes a little.

The Activity Field – normally not bookable for camping but the only real area for large District camps and therefore can be booked for camp after consultation with the Warden.

Small area between the camp fire and the toilet block – this area is designated as a group activity area and as such is not normally bookable without prior consultation with the warden.
