Health/Hygiene	All	Shower blocks and loos checked regularly. Any illness to be reported to the Event Team ASAP. Food stored hygienically. Hand sanitising gel to be available on all bases.	Troop Leaders Event team 1st Aider on call Base Leaders	Ongoing	Medium
Vehicles moving on site	All	Marshalls posted at entrances to site. On-site traffic heavily restricted. Speed limit on site to be adhered to.	Event Staff	Ongoing	Low
Trips, falls and accidents on site	All	Ensure correct footwear is worn. First aid cover with suitable first aid materials, will be available at the Base HQ for the duration of the camp. This will be staffed by individuals with minimum first response qualification.	Troop Leaders Event Staff	Ongoing	Medium
Uninvited guests on site	Young People	ALL adults and Young People to wear ID tags at all times.	All Adults to monitor	Ongoing	Medium
Weather	All	Appropriate clothing to be worn. In the event of extreme or severe weather the Event Leader may invoke a close down procedure.	Troop Leaders Scouts Event Staff	Ongoing	Low
Fire on waste ground	All	All Group Leaders to be briefed. In the event of fire all Leaders to safely direct everyone on site to assemble on either the recreation ground or Ebury Rise.	Event Staff All Adults	Ongoing	Low
Friday Night Challenge	Young People	Each base leader to be briefed and given the risk assessment. Personal first aid kits and anti-bacterial gel to be carried by all participants.	Base Leaders Troop Leaders Scouts	Ongoing	Low
Day Base Activities	Young People	Specific risk assessments for each base given to leaders running the bases. Personal first aid kits and anti-bacterial gel to be carried by all participants.	Base Leaders Troop Leaders Scouts	Ongoing	Low
Night Base Activities	Young People	Specific risk assessments for each base given to leaders running the bases.	Base Leaders	Ongoing	Medium
Night Hike	Young People	Teams to remain together. Hi viz jackets to be worn at all times on hike. Personal first aid kit and anti-bacterial gel to be carried by all participants. Scout teams to carry emergency phone. Event covered by two-way radios. Event pick-up staff & vehicles on standby.	Base Leaders Troop Leaders Scouts Event staff	Ongoing	Low
